Sunday 9 March

- **Moderator** | The Moderator will complete his tour of Tyrone Presbytery today. Pray for him as he takes the services at Bellaghy and Knockloughrim congregations. He will also give his testimony at the opening night of a mission in Magherafelt tonight. Give thanks for this opportunity and pray that those who hear it will be challenged about their own salvation.
- **Worship: Experiencing God's grace** | *As we worship today ask God to help us to know his forgiving and sustaining grace, pardoning our sins and providing for all our needs.*

Monday 10 March

- Naomi Leremore, global mission worker, Kenya | Give thanks for Naomi and the team in Nairobi as they prepare study materials for Theological Education by Extension. - International Relations | There are many global issues presenting significant challenges to world leaders.
